General

- Only the necessary teaching is arranged at the campuses. The necessary teaching was agreed on with the degree programme responsibles and the heads of the units in June.
- Students at high risk:
 - For students at high risk, alternative ways to learn and complete courses will be arranged.
 - Students must contact the teacher directly to inquire about alternative modes of completion.
 - Students will not be required to explain why they consider themselves to be at high risk from the coronavirus.
 - Cases where a mandatory course contains contact teaching (e.g. laboratory work) which cannot be organized in a remote mode will be dealt with case by case. Please contact the degree programme responsible, heads of study services (Susanna.Ketola@tuni.fi, Tuija.Puntanen@tuni.fi) and vice dean for education (Kati.Iltanen@tuni.fi)
- **Teachers and academic tutors** are recommended to fill in **attendance sheets** to keep a record all those who participate in face-to-face sessions. This information is **used to trace infection chains** if needed.
